Felix Meritis

Felix Meritis, a historic building from 1788, was originally established as the home of an intellectual society dedicated to the Arts and Sciences, embodying the Enlightenment spirit. Its design includes an iconic oval concert hall, a large library, and spaces for scientific experiments and art events, all connected by a grand central staircase under a domed roof once used for astronomy. Recently renovated, the venue now combines modern amenities with its historical charm. During the Metamaterials '25, Felix Meritis will offer quiet workspaces, networking opportunities, lunch catering and the conference welcome drinks.

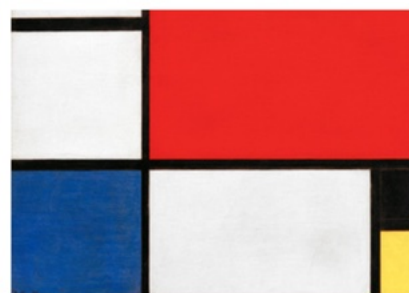

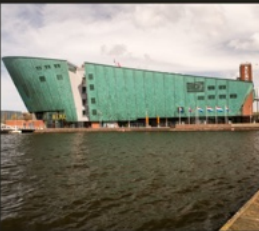
